DISTRICT OF LOWER BAVARIA

Lower Bavaria is both. A District, as well as an equal area administrative district in the Free State of Bavaria. It is situated in the east of Bavaria and borders in the north to the upper Palatinate, in the northeast to the Czech Republic (southern Bohemia, Pilsen region), in the southeast on upper Austria (Innviertel, Mühlviertel) and in southwest to upper Bavaria.

The term "Lower Bavaria" appeared for the first time in 1255 when the Bavarian state was divided. The name Lower Bavaria relates to its relative position on the Isar (downstream Upper Bavaria). A considerable part of Lower Bavaria, with the wide agricultural areas, small villages, hamlets, and deserted farms that are also characteristic of the region, is still almost untouched by tourism.

Geologically, Lower Bavaria is predominantly divided into two parts. There is a low mountain range with crystalline source rock, namely the Bavarian Forest east of the Donau and the hilly region west of the Donau. Colloquially, Lower Bavaria is often referred to as the "granary of Bavaria".



BAD GRIESBACH

"Bad Griesbach im Rottal" is a town and health resort amidst the Passau district and is located in the Lower Bavarian spa triangle. "Griesbach Castle" was first mentioned in documents around the year 1076. Griesbach was elevated as a city on September 2, 1953.

Griesbach has thermal springs, whose waters come from a depth of 1,500 meters. In 1973 the city was designated as a state-recognized climatic health resort. In 1977, a municipal spa-centre was opened and in 1979 the three thermal springs, which give the name to the three-spring bath ("Dreiquellenbad"), were recognized by the state.

In addition to lively customs, cultural and scenic highlights, worth seeing, visitors to the Lower Bavarian spa triangle in Bad Griesbach also may enjoy the largest continuous golf resort in Europe.


MUNICIPALITY OF KARPFHAM

The town of Karpfham was first mentioned in a document in 903 as an ancient Bavarian settlement. In 1162, Duke Henry the Lion held a "Thing" (this is a court day) here, which is seen as the origin of the Karpfham festival. As a result of the regional reform in 1972, the previously independent municipality of Karpfham became part of Griesbach.

Karpfham became also known as a Marian pilgrimage site. Most famous is Karpfham, on the other hand, through the "Karpfhamer Fest", which is combined with the "Rottalschau" trade fair.

The venue for the 96th International F.I.C.C. is amidst the idyllic community of Karpfham on a well-developed property terrain, just outside the city. It offers a lot of space and is very good to reach.


RALLY SITE

For celebrating our 96th International F.I.C.C. Rally, we found the perfect Rally site. The Karpfham folk festival site takes place on the same grounds every year, together with the Rottalschau trade fair. This ensures, that there is very good access to the site and enough space.

The site is located just outside the town of Karpfham.

In Karpfham you will find a café/bakery and restaurants. On the opposite side of the B388 there is a food store shop and access to the largest continuous golf resort in Europe.

Further shopping opportunities for your daily needs as well as medical aid, gas stations and much more are situated in Bad Griesbach, which lays approx. 5km away.



DIRECTIONS

OWN VEHICLE

... from the north

Motorway A3 Nürnberg/Regensburg, exit Pocking. From there take the B12 to the exit onto the B388. Follow this road for approx. 15 kilometer.

... from the east

Austrian motorway A1, to Germany on the A3, take the first exit Pocking. From there take the B12 to the exit onto the B388. Follow this for approx. 15 kilometer.

... from the south

From Braunau on the B12 to the little town of Simbach am Inn to Tutting. There, follow the signs at the intersection for approx. 15 kilometer to Bad Griesbach.

... from the west

A94/B12 Munich/Passau via Simbach am Inn to Tutting. There you follow the signs at the intersection for approx. 15 kilometer to Bad Griesbach.

AIRPLANE

It is around 145 kilometer from Munich airport, and around 100 kilometer from Salzburg and Linz airport to Bad Griesbach. There are numerous connecting connections at the airports.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

You can also travel comfortably by bus. From many cities there are bus connections to Bad Griesbach. Further information you can get it from Regionalbus Ostbayern GmbH.


